Members: \$160, Non-members: \$180.

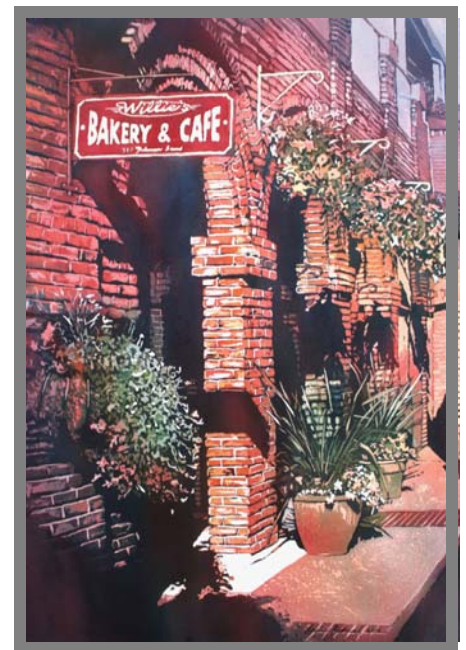
